In partnership with CRY (Child Rights and You), the centre endeavours to empower children by offering equitable access to education, digital literacy and opportunities for their holistic development. The need for the DLC has emerged with a stark digital divide that has emerged in recent times, widening the gap between privileged and underprivileged children, with special focus on girls who are being disproportionately affected.



Operational Highlights

Through our work, we have observed an alarming trend: a steep increase in dropout rates among girls, particularly as they advance to higher grades. Economic hardships, societal barriers, inadequate infrastructure, and a lack of digital access prevent them from continuing their education, limiting their future opportunities. If unaddressed, this gap will further hinder their social and economic mobility, reinforcing cycles of poverty and gender disparity.
