THE INITIATIVES

AIM Trust, through its SEE (Skills, Employment, Empowerment) initiative, addresses key vulnerabilities faced by persons with disabilities ranging from physical and sensory impairments to intellectual and developmental challenges.

AIM Trust promotes inclusive skilling and employment by collaborating with partners like NAB India and CII. The SEE 2025 event focused on accessible training programs, inclusive hiring practices, and community-based solutions to build a more equitable ecosystem for PwDs. Lived experiences shared during the event highlighted real barriers, such as the need for accessible infrastructure and respectful workplace cultures. Practical suggestions like disability ID tags and leadership awareness were proposed to reduce stigma and ensure dignity.
